

Types of Membership

YOU CAN JOIN ALARM AS AN INDIVIDUAL, GROUP, AFFILIATE OR NON-ACTIVE MEMBER.

INDIVIDUAL

Individual membership is for employees of public service organisations with an interest in or responsibility for risk management. Individual membership gives you access to the full range of benefits and discounts available to Alarm members.

GROUP – PAY FOR 5, GET ONE FREE!

Any public or not-for-profit organisation which is willing and able to contribute to Alarm's aims and objectives can join as a Group member. Group membership gives 6 named members for the price of 5 with each member being entitled to the full range of Alarm benefits and discounts.

AFFILIATE INDIVIDUAL

This type of membership is for any individual working in, or whose business is associated with, the field of risk management outside of the public and not-for-profit sectors, and who is willing and able to contribute to the aims and objectives of Alarm. Affiliate members are entitled to most of the benefits and discounts available to Individual Alarm members.

AFFILIATE GROUP – PAY FOR 5, GET ONE FREE!

Up to 6 employees of an organisation outside the public or not-for-profit sectors, working in, or whose business is associated with, the field of risk management, and which is willing and able to contribute to Alarm's aims and objectives can take out an affiliate body membership.

RETIRED / NON-ACTIVE

This type of membership is open to any person who has been a member of Alarm for at least the previous 5 years (or in special circumstances, such shorter period as determined by the Board), who has retired or is not currently active in gainful employment and who is willing and able to contribute to the aims and objectives of the organisation. Members in this category are entitled to some of the benefits and discounts available to Individual Alarm members.

STUDENT / UNEMPLOYED

Student membership is for any person studying full time for a recognised risk management degree or who has been made redundant from their current position and is actively seeking re-employment in the public sector. Members in this category are entitled to some of the benefits and discounts available to Individual Alarm members
